## RIGHT ATTITUDE TO LAUNCHING FORTH Luke 8:22-25

We have been talking about thrusting out and launching forth lately. We learnt about the life of Abraham and how he obeyed God and he launched into his destiny. We also learnt about 4 things that happens when you lunch forth:

- 1. Something new happens in your destiny.
- 2. Tremendous heavenly blessings locate you
- 3. Great things explode in your direction
- 4. You will be a channel of blessings to your generation.

Each proclamation of each month is very important. Today we want to look at RIGHT ATTITUDES TO LAUNCHING FORTH. These are:

#### 1. RIGHT ATTITUDE TO THE WORD OF LIFE

A story of two jolly friends teaches us so many lessons like Determination, To never give up on your self, That you are poor today does not mean God cannot make you rich, Strive to be hardworking, See every chance you have in life as an opportunity etc - Isaiah 1:19-20.

Abraham was willing & obedient to the voice of the Lord - Genesis 12:4. He launched forth by obeying the Word of God.

Another example is Simon Peter. After toiling for several hours, been a blessing to the master Himself, the Lord command him to launch out into the deep - Luke 5:4-5. Peter responded by saying, "Nevertheless at thy Word."

What is our attitude to the Word of Life we hear on a daily basis? Are we obedient to the Word of Life or not? Do we have a right attitude to the Word of Life?

# Welcome

Welcome to the month of May, where God of Heaven will "MAKE HASTE TO HELP YOU". Psalm 70:1 - Make haste, O God, to deliver me; make haste to help me, O Lord.

In six different places in the book of psalm, David pledged that God should help him not just to help him at His own convenient time but God should make haste to help him.

This month and in the months to come, God of Heaven and earth will make haste to help you and all that is yours.

To make haste to help you is to speedily send help to you in time of trouble. To instantly deliver help to you at the very nick of time. David was confidently assured that it's only the living God that can speedily help him in all circumstances of life.

#### 2. RIGHT ATTITUDE TOWARDS OTHERS COUNSEL

In the case of Naaman it was his attitude to his slave girl. In a servant to master relationship you must have the right attitude to workers, staffs, subordinates etc. Naaman had right attitude towards others people's counsel, he did not shut the servant down or common nice her testimony or counsel. He launched forth immediately to the essence of reporting the matter to the King & the king advised him to launched forth - 2 Kings 5:3-5.

#### 3. RIGHT ATTITUDE TOWARDS YOUR TOMORROW

Your tomorrow could represent your marriage, children etc. Hebrews 13:4 - Marriage is honourable in all, and the bed undefiled: but whoremongers and adulterers God will judge. To have a bright future, you've got to have the right attitude. Don't short change your destiny.

Hosea 4:6 - My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children.

#### 4. RIGHT ATTITUDE TOWARDS GOD

Give thanks to God in all circumstances. Sing praises to Him. I have personally recorded great healings just by praising God. Psalm 92:1-2 - It is a good thing to give thanks unto the Lord, and to sing praises unto thy name, O most High: To shew forth thy lovingkindness in the morning, and thy faithfulness every night.

Solomon offered praises and he got a blanc cheque. What is your attitude to wards your service toward God LUKE 5:110?
